TRANSLATION NOTES

Wakizashi, page 22



Meaning "side insert," a *wakizashi* is a sword worn at a warrior's side along with his longer katana as a symbol of his samurai status. This blade can be used as a backup sword, or for closer combat.


Okakatō, page 23



The name of Mukuro's secret weapon literally means "bonito flakes blade," where bonito is a type of fish—possibly one of Mukuro's favorites. Or perhaps she named her sword after the tasty treat because together, *okakatō* means "heel," as in "the heel of the foot."

Himemasu Castle, page 32

This castle bears a striking resemblance to the real life historical fortress, Himeji Castle, which was awarded by the shogun Tokugawa Ieyasu to his son-in-law for the latter's service in the battle of Sekigahara. The name Himemasu may be more palatable to the characters of *Nekogahara*, as it is the Japanese word for the sockeye salmon, and it is ruled by the Shakegawa, whose name means "salmon skin".



The katana used by samurai is a single-edged sword, meaning it's sharp on one side and blunt on the other. Striking one's enemy with the blunt side of the blade is a way to teach them a lesson while letting them live to remember it.

Ishidai Tsunari, page 121



The name of the man Short is remembering will perhaps bring two things to the mind of a Japanese reader. The first is the striped beakfish, or *ishidai*. A few of these fish became famous for taking up residence in a ship that broke loose and went adrift after the Tohoku Earthquake and following tsunami in 2011, earning them the name "tsunami fish." The second thing Japanese readers will remember is the name Ishida Mitsunari, who was a military commander who fought, and lost, in the battle of Sekigahara.

Netherworld Soul-Reaper, page 129

The name of Short's special move is rife with wordplay. In Japanese, it is *jigoku no kama-otoshi*. The first part, *jigoku no*, is straightforward enough, meaning "of or relating to hell, the netherworld, etc." *Kama-otoshi* can mean "sickle drop," as in bringing a sickle down either to harvest grain or to strike an enemy. In Japan, a small sickle was often connected to a heavy weight via a chain, creating a weapon not entirely unlike Short's kendama. *Kama* is also the word for the



head of a fish, and *kama-otoshi* is the removal of the fish's head in preparation for cooking, hence the alternate spelling for this attack name: Netherworld Sole-Reaper.

Nobunyaga's Ambition, page 156

Nobunyaga's Ambition is a spinoff of the *Nobunaga's Ambition* game series, in which all the characters—who are real Japanese historical figures—are reimagined as cats. It's a social game that can be played on mobile devices, and for a time was available in North America as *Samurai Cats*. The game had a collaboration with this manga series, in which players could obtain in-game items featuring artwork by Hiroyuki Takei.

Success story in the making, page 160



Kinoshita Tōkittyrō, known in human form as Kinoshita Tōkichirō, began his career as a lowly foot soldier, but eventually became the successor to Nobunaga himself and the second of Japan's unifiers, who put an end to the Warring States Period.

One realm under one cat, page 162

This is the feline version of one translation of Oda Nobunaga's historical slogan, *tenka fubu*, or "one realm under one sword." The slogan, which he used on his personal seal to sign all written correspondence, announced his intention to unify the nation, which up to that point had been in a state of constant civil war.



The Black-Toothed Daimyō, page 164



Imyagawa is seen here wearing the traditional dress of the nobles of his time, including the black lacquer over his teeth. Even though he was busy waging war, he still took the time to apply his makeup as a sign of his courtly sensibilities.
